In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.31 dated 08.05.2018, under Sections 22 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 29/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 added later on) registered at Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner name has been cropped up in the aforesaid FIR on the disclosure statement of the main accused-Saudagar Singh. Undisputedly, petitioner is not involved in any other case so also there is no recovery from him. Petitioner is in custody since 24.05.2018.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

4. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially having regard to the fact that petitioner is not involved in any other case and investigation has already been completed, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

5. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Gurjit Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
