Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.288 dated 21.03.2018 under Sections 420, 406, 468, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Vide order dated 13.09.2018, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

It has been reported that Arvinder Singh, the main accused, who is already on regular bail, has not put in appearance before the

Mediation and Conciliation Centre. Petitioners are claiming to be *bona fide* purchasers and they have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that the custody of the petitioners is no more required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custody is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 04.07.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
