The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 of Criminal Procedure Code for grant of regular bail in FIR No.31 dated 18.05.2018, under Sections 380, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') registered at Police Station Joga, District Mansa.

It is the allegation against the petitioner that she used the matriculation certificate of Kulwinder Kaur @ Beant Kaur daughter of Dara Singh to secure the service in a private factory (Trident), Dhaula. Recovery has already been effected from her. She is in custody since 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2018. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody since the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future.

Keeping in view the peculiar circumstances of the case, the petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety to the satisfaction of the learned Area/Duty Magistrate and subject to the conditions, if so imposed, by that court.
