Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.126 dated 16.06.2018 under Sections 306 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Matour, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

It is the case of the petitioners that deceased Supinder Singh was married to petitioner no.1 - Karandeep Kaur Hundal. They had approached this Court by filing CRM-M-40232-2016 to seek protection to their life and liberties and this Court vide order dated 10.11.2016 granted protection to them. The allegation against petitioner no.1 is that deceased

Supinder Singh committed suicide on account the harassment caused by petitioner no.1 to him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, does not dispute the fact of granting protection to the petitioner no.1 – Karandeep Kaur Hundal and the deceased - Supinder Singh vide order dated 10.11.2016 passed in CRM-M-40232-2016 *Karandeep Kaur Hundal & another Vs. State of Punjab & ors.* However, he submits that recovery of five mobile phones and a laptop is still required to be effected from the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the complainant has adopted the arguments, as put forward by learned State counsel.

Considering the fact that deceased - Supinder Singh had already approached this Court, claiming himself to be husband of petitioner no.1, the interim order dated 04.07.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition is disposed of.
