In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.32 dated 23.02.2018 registered under Sections 392/395/342/457/380 IPC at Police Station Bagha Purana.

2. Custody certificate filed by the State in Court today is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that challan has been filed on 7.6.2018. It is further submitted that co-accused of the petitioner has been extended the benefit of regular bail vide order dated 10.05.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-19083 of 2018.

4. Learned State counsel vehemently opposed the bail application of the petitioner. It was further submitted that petitioner and co-accused were involved in FIR No.41 dated 1.3.2018 registered at Police Station Shahkot and FIR No.89 dated 11.2.2018 registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon. However, he admitted the fact of extending the benefit of bail to the co-accused of the petitioner vide order dated 10.05.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-19083 of 2018.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
5. Having regard to the fact that co-accused of the petitioner has been extended the benefit of regular bail vide order dated 10.05.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-19083 of 2018., petitioner-Mahavir Singh is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
6. However, Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.
7. Petitioner shall also appear before the Station House Officer concerned on the last Saturday of every month at about 10.00 A.M.
8. Petition is allowed accordingly.
