Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.348 dated 12.06.2018 under Sections 120-B/406/420/467/468/471 IPC, registered at Police Station Shivaji Colony, District Rohtak.

2.) This Court vide order dated 06.08.2018 had directed the

petitioner to join investigation and in the event of arrest by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

3.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parkash Chand, submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 06.08.2018, petitioner appeared and joined investigation. It is further submitted that petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation in the present case.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 06.08.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. Petitioner shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

5.) The petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6.) Petition stands allowed.
