In the instant petition, petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.31 dated 28.05.2018 under Sections 341/323/324/506/148/149/326 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur.

2.) This Court vide order dated 26.09.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of arrest by the Investigating Officer, petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

3.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh, submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 26.09.2018, petitioner appeared before the Investigating Officer and joined the investigation. It is

further submitted that petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation in

the present case.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 26.09.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. Petitioner shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

5.) Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6.) Petition stands allowed.
