ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for discharge by taking all the pleas/defences along with all the supporting documents, before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the personal appearance of the petitioner may be exempted, before the trial Court.

Prayer made is accepted and the personal appearance of the petitioner is exempted before the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:

- (i) shall be represented through his counsel;
- (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- (iii) shall not dispute his identity as accused;
- (iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in his absence but in the presence of his counsel;
- (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court; and
- (vi) any other condition which the trial Court may impose.
