Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.101 dated 24.05.2018 under Sections 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 04.07.2018: -

“As per the version given in the FIR, the police stopped a car and two persons ran away from the spot and on search, bottles of liquor meant for sale in Haryana were recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that recovery has already been effected and the prosecution version that despite availability of the police party, the petitioner ran away from the spot, is not believable.

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Notice of motion for 03.10.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurjant Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 04.07.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
