Prayer in this petition is for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No. 5 dated 03.01.2018 under Sections 307, 120-B, 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kharkhoda, Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no injury has been caused by the petitioner in this alleged incident. He further submits that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Ramesh and Vishal have already been granted concession of bail vide orders dated 13.03.2018 and 22.03.2018 respectively, by the trial Court. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 16.01.2018 and no witness has been examined so far.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Yudhvair Singh does not dispute the facts that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner and the co-accused of the petitioner have already been released on bail.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, considering the facts that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 16.01.2018; no injury has been attributed to the petitioner; co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted concession of bail and the conclusion of the trial will take long time, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
