The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.19, dated 09.02.2018, registered at Police Station City Samana, District Patiala, under sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act, 1985.

2. The FIR came to be registered on the basis of secret information. Thereafter, the police raided the house of the co-accused-Rajinder Kumar alias Ballu and two kilograms of poppy-husk have been recovered from his residence. He also suffered his disclosure statement that a total of eighty kilograms poppy-husk have been brought in the Car of Khushi Ram from Madhya Pradesh. Two kilograms out of that had been recovered and rest of the seventy eight kilograms is in the said Swift Car parked at a particular place and the same can be got recovered on his demarcation.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in fact the balance amount of seventy eight kilograms of poppy-husk were recovered from the car belonging to

the petitioner-Khushi Ram. Apart from that, there are six other cases under NDPS Act, 1985, pending against the petitioner.

- 4. Keeping in view the aforementioned facts and circumstances of this case, I do not find appropriate ground for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.
- 5. Thus, the petition is accordingly dismissed.
- 6. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to file afresh petition at a later stage, depending upon the circumstances of the case.
