MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.99 dated 21.03.2018 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirkha, District Mewat-Nuh.

On 05.07.2018 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that organization of petitioner i.e. Mewat Mazdoor Karva Union, Mewat is not a registered organisation. However, it is maintaining accounts and record of all its members and money received through various persons. Co-accused named in this FIR have been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 30.05.2018 passed in CRM-M-21223-2018.

Notice of motion for 12.09.2018.

Petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall

abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.

On the next date, learned counsel for the petitioner will produce complete documents regarding constitution of Mewat Mazdoor Karva Union, Mewat and maintenance of account by it. He will also supply copy of the same to investigating officer for report.

Be listed alongwith CRM-M-21223-2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 05.07.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Ravinder Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 05.07.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
