FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 10.10.2018 of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Mandeep Kaur and the accused namely Bhupinder Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise Ex.P1 has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure matrimonial dispute and the fact that offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in ‘Gian

Singh v. State of Punjab and another’ 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543
and ‘Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another’
2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is
allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.200 dated 14.09.2017 registered
at Police Station Phase I, SAS Nagar (Mohali) under Sections 406/498-A
IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners
are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
