In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail in case FIR No.138 dated 11.08.2017, under Sections 302/201/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1).

2.) The allegations are that petitioner is one of the accused insofar as alleged murder of one Harvinder Singh @ Kaka husband of Kiranjot Kaur. Such allegations have been made with reference to the disclosure statement made by Kiranjot Kaur who is one of the accused. It was submitted that Kiranjot Kaur and co-accused have been extended the bail by this Court vide Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively.

3.) Learned counsel for the State submitted that complainant has been examined and trial is going on.

4.) Heard.

5.) In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail; therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Rakesh Kumar @ Keshi is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned subject to the following conditions:-

(i)Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

(ii)Petitioner shall appear before the Station House Officer concerned on last Saturday of every month at 10.00 a.m. and mark his presence.

(iii)Petitioner shall deposit a sum of ₹ 1,00,000/- in the Trial Court and he shall surrender his passport in the Trial Court, if he possesses the same. In case, he does not possess the same, in that event he shall furnish an affidavit to that effect in the Trial Court.
