Petitioner Monu @ Raman has filed this petition seeking grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.760 dated 21.9.2017 under Sections 21, 27-A, 61 and 85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station City, Sirsa, District Sirsa.

The allegations in nutshell are that the petitioner-Monu @ Raman was found in possession of 64.33 grams of heroin.

The learned counsel for the State upon instruction from ASI Satish Kumar, who is present in Court, has informed that the petitioner has been behind bars since the last more than 9 months. He has, however, informed that the petitioner is also facing trial in two other cases in respect of recovery of contraband in which he had been granted bail.

Bearing in mind the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that the conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner behind bars any further.

In view of abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner Monu @ Raman is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned, subject to the condition that petitioner Monu @ Raman will not indulge in any activity akin to one for which he has been convicted. In case of any such eventuality the prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek the cancellation of the order granting bail to the petitioner.
