In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0091 dated 22.06.2016, under Sections 457, 380 IPC registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar City.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is in custody since 01.06.2018. No purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar as trial of the case would take some time.

3. On instructions of ASI Karam Chand, learned State counsel submitted that challan has been presented on 31.07.2018.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is in custody since 01.06.2018 and disposal of the trial will take sufficient time, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

6. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Vyom @ Viyom Arora is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

7. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

8. Petition stands allowed.
