The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.23 dated 29.03.2018, registered at Police Station Rori, District Sirsa, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985.

The version in the FIR is that the petitioner was riding pillion on a scooter when the scooter was stopped by the police party. From the petitioner, 1200 tablets of Alprozolam were recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been wrongly implicated. The contents of the FIR itself show that a false story has been concocted. Moreover, the petitioner is in custody since 29.03.2018 and the investigation in this case is already complete. There is no other case pending against the petitioner and thus, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him in custody indefinitely.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Rajesh Kumar, submits that one another case under Section 429 IPC, is pending against the petitioner. It is, further submitted that the report of the FSL has not received till date. It is not denied that the investigation in this case is complete.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since

29.03.2018 and that report of the FSL has still not been received, I deem it

appropriate to release the petitioner on bail till the receipt of report of the FSL. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to released on bail till the receipt of the report of the FSL, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Judge, Special Court concerned. Thereafter, on the date of receipt of report of the FSL, the petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court/Judge, Special Court concerned and shall seek regular bail afresh.
