Prayer in this petition is for quashing of order dated 08.08.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar whereby interim maintenance for a sum of ₹9,000/- has been granted to the respondent and order dated 07.12.2016 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar whereby revision petition filed by the petitioner has been dismissed.

Notice of motion was issued, in this case, subject to deposit of ₹11,000/- with the Registry of this Court, to be paid as litigation expenses to the respondent. However, despite opportunities, litigation expenses were not deposited, due to which notice could not be issued.

Following order was passed on the last date of hearing:-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks one last opportunity to deposit litigation expenses as directed on 03.07.2017. May do so within two weeks. Pursuant thereto, let fresh notice be issued to respondent for 10.05.2018.

In case needful is not done, this petition shall be dismissed for non-prosecution.”

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As per office report, litigation expenses have not been deposited so far. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner as well.

Present petition is, accordingly, dismissed for non-prosecution.
