By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.0086 dated 16.5.2018 registered under Sections 420, 406, 465, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 5.7.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur has been received to the effect that statements of the complainant Daksh and also of Rupinder Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter with the accused Ranjit Singh and that they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed. To the similar effect is the statement of the petitioner Ranjit Singh. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate,

Hoshiarpur has specifically been opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.0086 dated 16.5.2018 registered under Sections 420, 406, 465, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
