A strange suit has been filed by the plaintiff seeking relief of mandatory injunction against the electricity supply company (formally known as Punjab State Electricity Board). The relief claimed in the suit is to direct the defendants to remove their high power electric wire passing above the plot/house owned by the plaintiff. Both the Courts after appreciating the evidence have found that high power electric wires were laid before the plaintiff purchased the property. Still further, as per the provisions of the Electricity Supply Act, any person feels aggrieved of a high power wire passing over his property is entitled to make a representation for redressal of his grievance under the Act. Hence, the Courts below have rightly dismissed the suit.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall stand disposed of accordingly.

Appeal is dismissed.
