Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner Bakshish Singh in case FIR No.58 dated 28.05.2018, registered under Sections 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

According to the prosecution, the petitioner was carrying 48 bottles of liquor without any permit or licence and on seeing police party, he fled away from the spot by leaving liquor bottles. According to the impugned order, the petitioner is facing trial in five more cases of similar nature, which shows that he is a habitual offender. Therefore, he does not deserve any concession of anticipatory bail, inasmuch as his custodial interrogation is very much necessary.

Dismissed.
