The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, “Cr.P.C”) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 25.4.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 18 of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substance Act and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Smalsar, District Moga.

Heard.

Learned State counsel submits that the recovery effected in this case falls within commercial quantity of contraband i.e. 5KG of opium.

No case is made out for grant of regular bail.

Dismissed. However, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial as early as possible preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
