The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case First Information Report No.9 dated 14.09.2011 under Sections 302, 201, 218, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station State Crime, SAS Nagar Mohali.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance of order dated 29.01.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation on 08.02.2018 and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

On instructions from Inspector Kulwant Singh, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and

stated that the custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the order dated 29.01.2018 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
