The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.130 dated 21.03.2018, registered under Sections 395, 397, 452, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mohindergarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that only *danda (stick)* was recovered from the petitioner.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 15.04.2018. The trial of the case will take time and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody any further.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Ajay alias Musa is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to

the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate,
Narnaul, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
