The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.101 dated 29.03.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 364-A, 328, 323, 201, 379 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Heard.

On instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, learned State counsel has submitted that complainant Dr. Aman Preet Singh did not suffer any injury but four persons along with his wife had given an injection to him. Thereafter, he was taken to Delhi and admitted in a de-addiction centre running under the name and style of Sampark Foundation but thereafter, petitioner along with Navneet and Sukhdev Singh had given beating but there is no injury in report. Learned State counsel has further submitted that he was not medico legal examined. Petitioner is in custody since 24th May, 2018.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Fateh Singh @ Shanky son of Bahadur Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
