Petitioner-Davinder Singh Randhawa has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.21 dated 17.12.2017, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Bathinda Range, Bathinda, under Sections 327, 166, 34 and 120-B of IPC read with Sections 7, 8, 13 (1) (d) and 13 (2) of the PC Act, 1988.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is not named in the FIR. FIR, in the present case, was registered on 17.12.2017. The main accused, Pawan who was apprehended in a trap, has already been released on bail. The present petitioner is named by co-accused Pawan after his release on bail.

The petitioner has been in custody since 17.05.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
