Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 001 dated 12.01.2018 for the offences punishable under Section 406/420/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Nagaal, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his name is not mentioned in the FIR. There is no allegation regarding any amount being paid to the petitioner as such. It is further contended that the petitioner is in custody since 02.05.2018. Nothing is recovered from him and that the trial would take a long time.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that there is an audio recording regarding some conversation of sending the son of the complainant to France.

Learned counsel for the complainant also submits that the

petitioner has given in writing to return the money during the course of investigation.

In view of the above submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the fact that the version of the State is yet to be tested before the Trial Court, the present petition is allowed, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.
