Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 01 dated 12.01.2018 for the offences punishable under Section 406/420/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Nagaal, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no allegation regarding the petitioner himself having received the money. It is further contended by learned counsel that in fact the present case has been thrust upon the petitioner because he is having a property dispute with the complainant. Moreover, the petitioner is in custody since 05.05.2018. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has submitted that one of the co-accused has still not been arrested. However, the remaining contentions have not been disputed.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.
