The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for the issuance of directions to the officials respondents No. 1 to 4 to register the case and to take action against private respondents No. 5 to 8.

During the course of hearing learned counsel for respondents No. 5 to 8 has stated that FIR No. 36 dated 04.04.2018 under Sections 379 and 409 of the Indian Penal Code Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural has been registered against Sukhvinder Singh Sokhal, Lakhwinder Singh Sokhal, Galzaar Singh and Davinder Singh Panch as well as some other persons have been nominated during investigation.

Since the FIR has also been registered and investigation

is going on in the matter, therefore, no further directions are required to be issued to respondents no. 1 to 4.

Needless to say that the Investigating Officer shall proceed in the matter strictly as per law.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies available to them under law.
