Petitioner Jaswinder Kaur has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.20 dated 16.12.2014, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, District Amritsar, under Section 13(1)(d) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and Sections 409/420/467/468/471/120-B of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The petitioner has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.20 dated 16.12.2014.

In compliance of interim order dated 05.07.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has

been released on interim bail. The petitioner is not required for interrogation purpose as she has only to face trial. Nothing has been recovered from her. No useful purpose would be served by sending her to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 05.07.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
