The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.63 dated 07.05.2018, registered at Police Station Odhan, District Sirsa, under Sections 22 and 27-A of NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been arrested in this case on the disclosure statement of a co-accused. The actual recovery was effected from the said co-accused, namely, Sukhraj Singh and he has been granted interim bail vide order dated 04.09.2018 passed in CRM-M-37035-2018.

Learned State counsel submits that commercial quantity of contraband was recovered. He however, does not dispute the fact that the FSL report has not been received till date.

In view of the fact that co-accused, namely, Sukhraj Singh has been granted interim bail vide order dated 04.09.2018 passed in CRM-M-37035-2018 and that report of the FSL has still not been received, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail till the receipt of report of the FSL. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to released on bail till the receipt of the report of the FSL, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Judge, Special Court concerned. Thereafter, on the date of receipt of report of the

FSL, the petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court/Judge, Special Court concerned and shall seek regular bail afresh.
