

Parminder Singh and ors. Vs. Gurdev Kaur and ors.

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Dharam Singh (deceased) was owner of about 77 kanal of land situated in Village Sohana along with share in shamlat deh and abadi deh, bara etc. as detailed in the civil suit filed by the present appellants. He had two daughters; Gurbax Kaur and Gurdev Kaur. Gurbax Kaur predeceased Dharam Singh, who left behind two sons and three daughters. Appellants-plaintiffs are L.Rs of Gurbax Kaur while Gurdev Kaur, the other daughter of Dharam Singh, is respondent/defendant in the civil suit filed for joint possession where challenge was made to the gift deed dated 13.08.1979 and registered Will dated 20.12.1977 of Dharam Singh. Trial Court dismissed the suit filed by the present appellants-plaintiffs. Present appellants-plaintiffs filed first appeal against the said judgment and decree passed by the trial Court, which was also dismissed by learned first Appellate Court. Aggrieved by the decisions of both the Courts below i.e. trial Court and first Appellate Court, the present regular second appeal has been filed by appellants-plaintiffs seeking joint possession of the property in dispute.

During pendency of the present regular second appeal, parties have entered into compromise, Ex.C-1. Parties are closely related. It has been stated that the entire land has already been acquired by government of Punjab and the dispute is regarding receiving the compensation and other

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has been filed. Statement of all the parties has been recorded. They have stated that they have understood the contents of said compromise and signed the same along with witnesses. They have also agreed to the contents of compromise vide separate statement given before us. Hence, in view of these facts, the present regular second appeal/suit is disposed of in terms of compromise, Ex.C-1. Compromise, Ex.C-1, shall form part of the decree sheet.
