The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in case FIR No. 0028 dated 7.4.2018 under Section 15/18 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Bakshiwala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that poppy straw weighing 9 Kg. was allegedly recovered from the petitioner which is a non-commercial quantity. He further submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 7.4.2018 and the investigation is complete. However, no PW has been examined. Thus, the petitioner may be granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel is not in a position to dispute the aforementioned factual submissions.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody since 7.4.2018 and that the investigation is complete, there is no other case pending or registered against the petitioner as well as the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition and grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Thus, the petition is allowed and the petitioner-Gurminder Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
