Prayer made in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents not to harass the petitioners at the behest of private respondent No.9-Tej Kaur.

It is stated in the petition that Tej Kaur (respondent No.9) had appointed Najar Singh as her General Power of Attorney so as to manage her property as well as to defend her cases. It is further averred that said Najar Singh had executed a sale deed with consent of respondent No.9 in favour of the petitioners and other members of his family. However, subsequently, respondent No.9 in connivance with other respondents as well as in connivance with Najar Singh have hatched a conspiracy to deprive of the petitioners of their land and to implicate them falsely in some criminal case.

The learned counsel has submitted that the aforesaid matter has already been inquired into by the police pursuant to filing of several complaints by respondent No.9 but the petitioners had been found innocent and the allegations were found to be baseless. The learned counsel has further submitted that a civil suit in respect of the alleged dispute is also pending. It has further been submitted that now respondent No.9 has again made another complaint dated 9.8.2017 before Inspector General of Police, Patiala which has been marked to Superintendent of Police Headquarter, Fatehgarh Sahib and that the petitioners are being regularly called in connection with the said complaint.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib (respondent No.7) to look into the matter, in accordance with law and to ensure that the petitioners are not unnecessarily harassed and to dispose of the complaint pending against them by also taking into account the instructions dated 5.1.2012 in respect of multiple inquiries issued by the Office of Director General of Police, Punjab.

A copy of this petition and copy of this order be sent to respondent No.7 to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
