The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.31 dated 30.03.2014 registered under Sections 302, 392, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act and Sections 341 and 120-B IPC added later on at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and the next date fixed before the trial Court is 16.11.2018 for recording of statement of defence witnesses.

Keeping in view the stage of trial, no ground is made out to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Dismissed.

However, the trial Court is directed to make all efforts to expedite the trial.
