The present petition has been filed seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 1 dated 04.01.2018 registered under Section 61 of Excise Act at Police Station Chhajali, District Sangrur.

According to the FIR, the police party spotted a Swift car approaching it. The driver of the Swift car stopped the same on seeing the police party. Then he ran away alongwith his companion. However, while running away, he was identified by Naib Singh son of Avtar Singh, who was standing with the police party. On checking the car, thirty boxes of country made liquor, were recovered.

The petitioner has been identified while running away from the spot and large quantity of country made liquor has been recovered.

Custodial interrogation of the petitioner will be necessary to uncover the illegal business of smuggling of country made liquor. There is no ground to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail.

The petition is dismissed.
