This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No.363 dated 09.06.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341 and 302 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal, Haryana (Annexure P-1).

Heard both sides.

Perused Case Diary. The petitioner stands on a similar footing with co-accused Rohit @ Bunty who has been granted bail today in CRM-M-36046-2017 for the detailed reasons mentioned in the concerned order. Suffice it to say there is no allegation against the petitioner of having used any fire-arm or having committed any act which could directly lead to death of the victim. He has undergone detention for an identical term as in case of co-accused Rohit @ Bunty. He may therefore be released on bail to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court with a further direction to report at a concerned Police Station once a week during pendency of trial.

It is made clear that no observation made in this order shall cast any reflection upon the merits of the case before the Trial Court, which shall come to its independent decision without being influenced by any such jurisdiction.
