JAISHREE THAKUR J.(Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0024 dated 25.4.2018, under Sections 452 and 354 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

Counsel for the petitioner herein contends that the petitioner is in custody since 25.4.2018 and the material witness has already been examined. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the bail application, while submitting that the allegations levelled against the

petitioner are of serious nature.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that material witnesses have already been examined and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
