Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of Complaint No.55/2017 instituted on 21.03.2017, under Sections 9(b) and 37(2) of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act (**Annexure P-1**), pending before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurdaspur.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 26.07.2017, passed the following order:-

“ *It is contended that the petitioners herein are the sister-in-law and brother-in-law (husband of petitioner No.1) of the complainant and separate in residence. In fact, they were married in the year 2005 much prior to the marriage between the complainant and brother of petitioner No.1.*

Notice of motion returnable by 05.12.2017.

In the meantime, proceedings qua the petitioners are stayed. ”

It has been pointed out by learned Counsel for the respondent that in view of the compromise, Complaint bearing No.55/2017, instituted on 21.03.2017, under Sections 9(b) and 37(2) of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act (**Annexure P-1**), stands withdrawn by the respondent.

In view of above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
