Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner during the pendency of trial in case FIR No.94 dated 09.04.2018 registered under Sections 420, 441, 452, 453, 448, 467, 468, 471, 506, 34 of IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonipat, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is in custody since 14.05.2018 and even otherwise, the matter has been compromised between the parties. He refers to the compromise deed dated 10.10.2018 entered between the petitioner-Ashok Kumar & others, and Rajiv Kumar-complainant & another.
