The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 89 dated 19.05.2018, under Sections 336, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Muktsar Sahib.

The operative part of the order dated 09.07.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegation in the FIR, the petitioner along with one Jagpreet Singh had fired from double barrel gun in front of the house of the complainant while travelling in the car. Learned counsel further submits that in the instant case, no one was injured and the petitioner is ready to join investigation and will hand over his double barrel gun and the car to the Investigating Officer. Learned counsel also submits that in fact, registration of the present FIR is the counter blast on earlier FIR which was got registered on the statement of the petitioner. Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC-Sukhdayal Singh, however, submits that he be directed to join investigation and hand over the

fire arm as well as car to the Investigating Officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 09.07.2018, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Vipin Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 09.07.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
