1. Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.827 dated 02.10.2017 under Sections 323, 379-B, 427 IPC registered at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad.

2. The occurrence took place at the time of inauguration of Old age Home in village Anangpur where chief guest of the function was invited. During inaugural ceremony, the complainant saw that a young person was breaking glasses of cars with a stick. When the complainant ran towards him, the boy hit danda on the person of the complainant and snatched an amount of Rs.2100/- and mobile of the complainant.

Thereafter, he ran away from the spot.

3. As per MLR of the injured, tenderness with reddish bruise discoloration over the lateral aspect of the left arm was found. No x-ray was done. The injury was found to be simple in nature.

4. Recoveries have already been effected.

5. After filing challan, charges have already been framed on 11.01.2018.

6. Petitioner is in custody since 02.10.2017.

7. This statement of fact has not been refuted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Phool Kumar.

8. In view of above, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

9. Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
