GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 200, dated 29.6.2008, registered at Police Station City, Kapurthala, under Sections 341, 506, 427, 149 and 188 IPC and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 26.9.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala has been received to the effect that statement of complainant Harbans Singh and also of petitioners/accused Naamdev @ Nami, Manohar Lal @ Pappu and

Parminder Singh @ Chanki have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant has specifically stated that he has no objection if the FIR in the present case is quashed. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala opined that the parties have entered into the compromise without there being any pressure, coercion or inducement.

In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 200, dated 29.6.2008, registered at Police Station City, Kapurthala, under Sections 341, 506, 427, 149 and 188 IPC and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
