This petition has been filed under Section 354-D in FIR No. 77 dated 23.08.2013, registered against the petitioner at Police Station MDC, Panchkula titled as 'State Versus L.S. Bedi' and all the subsequent proceedings arising out of it pending before the Court of Ms. Harleen A. Sharma, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Mohali.

The matter has been litigated for some time and without going into the merits or de-merits both counsel agreed for the transfer of this case out of the said Court. The only contention raised by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent No.2 is that the matter should not be delayed unnecessarily and that the petitioner herein

should be bound down to record his statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C to which no objection has been raised.

In view of the above statements, let this matter be sent back to the District and Sessions Judge, Panchkula for marking this case to an appropriate Court. Parties are directed to appear before the District and Sessions Judge, Panchkula on 28.05.2018 who in turn would assign the case to an appropriate Court. It is made clear that petitioner undertakes to have his statement recorded on any date so fixed by learned District and Sessions Judge, Panchkula.

In the meanwhile, proceedings pending before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula on 25.05.2018 are hereby stayed.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
