This is a petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 49 dated 28.06.2017 under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 324, 506, and 34 IPC later on 326 IPC added, registered at Police Station Saran Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that during the pendency of the proceedings before this Court, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre and with the able assistance of the Mediator, an amicable solution has been arrived at between the parties by settlement agreement dated 06.11.2017.
