1. In the present petition, petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 21, dated 05.02.2018, under Sections 457, 380, 379, 411 of IPC and 22/61/85 NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar.

2. Status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Dilbagh Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Shahkot, Jalandhar on behalf of respondent-State along with Annexure R-1 (disclosure statement) filed in Court today, is taken on record. In the disclosure statement, one of the accused has disclosed that stolen mobile phone and other accessories have been handed over to the petitioner. Thus, it is evident that petitioner was alleged to have involved in crime. Acceptance role of the petitioner is required to be examined with reference to stolen articles.

3. In view of these facts and circumstances and the fact that

petitioner is not involved in any other case, he is entitled anticipatory bail. Present petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting / Investigating Officer subject to petitioner joining investigation as and when called for and he will also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
