Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.306 dated 18.06.2018 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 406, 34 IPC at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 06.07.2018 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dharminder, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant states that genuineness of the transfer deed which was executed by petitioner No.1 in favour of petitioners No.2 and 3 is seriously in dispute.

Be that as it may, since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 06.07.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
