ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 494 dated 23.06.2017, registered under Sections 302, 201, 304-B, 34 IPC, Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar (Haryana).

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 23.06.2017 and statement of complainant and all other material witnesses has been recorded. Counsel contends that prior to marriage there was a condition that the couple would settle in Delhi and the deceased had remained in Delhi for 3 ½ years and she came to the village before one month prior to her death and this is the reason that she had committed suicide because she does not want to live in the village. Counsel for the petitioner says that the mother-in-law is also facing trial, who has been granted bail by the trial Court and there are two sons who are living with the petitioner's family.

The trial would take time. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate.
