Interim bail was allowed to the petitioner on the last date of hearing. Petitioner had brought a draft of Rs.4,10,000/- and he was willing to return the amount taken by him.

The complainant had sought time to take instructions whether the draft was to be accepted.

The complainant was to come but they have not reached.

A demand draft amounting to Rs.5.15 lakh has been brought by the petitioner. The draft be deposited with the Registry and then Registry would give the draft to the complainant upon moving an application to the Registry for release of the demand draft by the complainant.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 10.09.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
