The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.62 dated 22.03.2018 registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, under Sections 306, 34 of IPC.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the deceased person was a self styled godman. He used to administer cures to sick people. The wife of the petitioner died due to a cure administered by him and thus, the villagers turned against him. It was in fact a case of misunderstanding and parties are residing in the same village and for maintaining peace and harmony, the FIR may be quashed.

Pursuant to order dated 06.07.2018, report dated 17.08.2018, has been received from Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or

coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.62 dated 22.03.2018 registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, under Sections 306, 34 of IPC, alongwith all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioners.
